

Fellowship of Christian Teaching Homes Co-op

FCTH co-op is a ministry of FCTH. Therefore, all information about co-op is available only to our members via email loop and forum posts.

FCTH co-op began during the 2007-2008 school year and has been hosted by Living Word Fellowship Church since its first semester. We meet every Friday morning for 13 weeks in the Fall and 13 weeks in the Spring. Biblically based classes run from 9:00 AM until 11:30 AM. All parents are expected to stay on site during co-op and serve as a teacher, teacher's helper, or administrator.

The fee for co-op is \$45 per family per semester regardless of how many classes are taken or how many children are in a family. Some classes do require the purchase of additional materials. Each family member from 4 years old through adult will have to own an FCTH t-shirt in order to abide by the dress code.

Prior to fall 2009, no family has had to wait more than one semester to get into the FCTH co-op. We have searched all summer for a larger church to host co-op, but at this point it appears that the Lord has plans for us to stay at LWF.

You may have your family added to the wait list for co-op at any time by contacting the current co-op leader via email or phone.

Current Co-op Members are given the first opportunity to register for each new semester. After current co-op member registration is completed, families on the waiting list will be contacted by email regarding any new openings. If there are no openings, they can choose to have their name removed from or kept on the waiting list. If they choose to keep their name on the waiting list, they will be at the top of the new semester's waiting list.

Usually, families are assigned to co-op openings in the order they are listed on the waiting list. However, it doesn't always work out that way. For example, a family may drop and open up spots for a 4th, 5th and 10th grader. If the first few families on the waiting list do not have kids in those grades, we will go down the list to the first family that fits the openings.

If all waiting list families are accommodated, then an email and forum post to all FCTH members will be sent with information regarding any remaining spaces.

Hopefully this has answered many questions regarding how our co-op works. Please be in prayer for our co-op as the Lord guides us.
