Statement of Christian Faith

Attending a Field Trip

- 1) FCTH members will be given first priority to attend field trips (please see priority order below).
- 2) If you must cancel, please call your field trip coordinator as soon as possible as a courtesy to our other members and the facility we are attending. We often have a waiting list and if we are notified soon enough, will be able to fill vacant spots.
- 3) We schedule many field trips each month for all different ages and with different price ranges. We do not want anyone to feel obligated to attend ALL scheduled events. There are many events scheduled so that each family can pick and choose what works best for their family.
- 4) EARLY arrival is necessary as a courtesy to the person or facility hosting our field trip. All field trips will start promptly at the time announced in order to respect the time of our speakers and families.
- 5) Remember FCTH is representing God, Christians and Homeschooling to our community. Reviewing expectations and appropriate behavior with students, **prior** to group functions, will reduce the need for parents to discipline or remove children and ensure that the experience is safe and enjoyable for all in attendance. Please refer to By-Laws if you are unsure about the expected behavior of children.

Priority for field trips will be given in this order:

- 1) FCTH members
- 2) Extended family of FCTH members
- 3) Homeschool families who are new to our area, but have not yet joined FCTH.
- 4) Visitors accompanying FCTH family who are currently homeschooling, but not member of FCTH (as intro. to benefits of our group).
- 5) Visitors accompanying FCTH family who do not homeschool, but are considering homeschooling

When space is limited for a field trip then no spot will be given to #2-5 until all children in #1 who want to attend have been given a spot. If there are spots remaining after that point, then children and adults in #2-5 may be accommodated as space allows.

We will not provide field trip spaces for individuals who are not associated with FCTH in one of the above ways.

Please remember that field trips are a part of the ministry of FCTH, to encourage and support members. We have been blessed to have so many like-minded families involved in the activities that we have planned! We have prayerfully set priorities in order to honor our commitment to the members of FCTH and to be able to offer encouragement to new/relocated homeschooling families in our community as modeled in Titus 2. Thank you so much for honoring this policy.
